Individual Support

At Your Hospice of North Central Oklahoma, our dedicated professionals are available to provide support as you journey through grief and loss. We offer supportive counseling either in person, by phone or mail.

Support Groups

We provide a safe and supportive place to share your experiences of loss and to learn different ways to cope and heal from each other. We provide support groups for children and adults.

Lunch Bunch

This is a great group of individuals that meet for lunch every second and fourth Tuesday to socialize and help you along your grief journey.

Community and Educational Services

Work through your journey of grief by attending workshops and in-services throughout the year. We also offer a library of materials to help you understand your feelings of loss and assist you through your time of grief.

Memorial Service

At Your Hospice of North Central Oklahoma, we hold an annual candlelight service for our community to honor those who we love that have passed.

Memory Quilts

Memory quilt squares are provided to the bereaved families to personalize and remember their loved ones. These are sewn into a quilt that is displayed in the Hospice office. These memory quilts are for Hospice families as well as community bereaved families.

Memory Bears

For Hospice of North Central Oklahoma patient families, an article of clothing of the deceased is used to create a Memory Bear. Volunteers refashion the garment into a bear for the families to keep.

Butterfly Wings

Coping with the grief of miscarriage, stillbirth or infant death can be one of the most difficult trials in a person's life. You do not have to face this journey alone.
